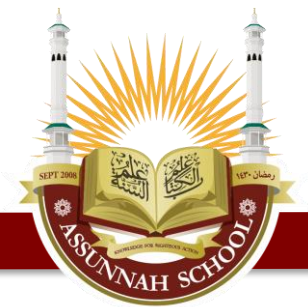

### School Fees

Just to remind parents that they must pay their monthly school fees on time, last month we chased up numerous of parents with delayed payments, we understand due to the current circumstances keeping to the payment deadline can be difficult, please come and speak with the School Manager, Ustadh Faisal or the Admin, Ustadha Mahima regarding this.

Arrangements have been made with parents that are yet to make payments from Autumn Term 1 and 2, please keep to your payment date. We will be chasing up fees on the 5<sup>th</sup> January to ensure parents have complied with their payment plan. Failure to do this will result in your child being removed from Assunnah Primary effective immediately.

Payments must be made by the beginning of the month from the 1<sup>st</sup> to the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month. If the deadline is not met a £15 fine will be administered which will be strongly enforced. Payments by direct debit are also available. I would like to also remind that this is an Amaanah upon the school.

### Attendance and Punctuality

Parents are reminded that all children are expected to be in every day at 8.00 am unless there is a valid reason for an authorized absence, parents must call the school office and inform reason of absence. Children who are going to be in late must call in to inform the school office before 8.15am. **Punctuality-** must be at a minimum of 97% this means a child cannot be late **more than twice** in a term! 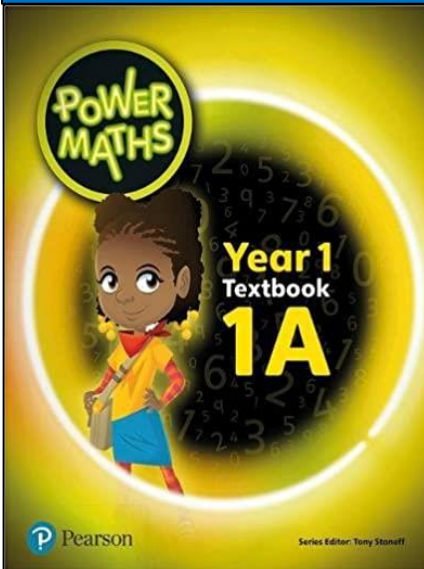
