All parents experience difficulties at various times that can be helped by other family members or close friends. If someone you know is having difficulties, you could offer the following:

- A listening ear
- Ideas to cope with problems
- Encouragement to get some help
- Practical support (childcare etc.)

However, there may be times when a child may be at risk of significant harm, and professional support needs to be provided. The safety & welfare of children is everyone's business. If parents/carers, staff, family or community members have concerns, they must report these concerns to the local safeguarding team.

Protecting children is your responsibility too...

We will discuss the four parts of abuse, (neglect, emotional, physical and sexual abuse.)

We will share our Safeguarding policy, Behavior policy and other policies related to safeguarding. You will also meet Assunnah Safeguarding Team

Our Aims:

- Establish and maintain an ethos where children feel secure, encouraged to talk, and listened to within an open and positive school atmosphere.
- Ensure that children have an identified member of staff in school who they can talk to and systems in place such as the "worry box" if they are worried or are in difficulty
- Every effort will be made to establish effective working relationships with parents and colleagues from other agencies, such as the police and social care.
- All teaching and non-teaching staff are aware of their need to safeguard children and their responsibilities in identifying and reporting possible cases of abuse and monitoring children known or thought to be at risk of harm.
