Injury caused to unsupervised children for example by slips/ trips on wet floorespecially at the end of lunchtime when most children have gone outside and catering staff have mopped the floor. The risk of injury is increased if children are left unsupervised. There is a greater risk of injuries be compounded by lack of swift first aid treatment, if children are left unsupervised.
